### Mark / Chapter 15

#### **Short Summaries**

The crowd chooses Barabbas over Jesus and demands that Jesus be crucified. Pilate washes his hands of the matter, and Jesus is crucified.

Roman soldiers mock and beat Jesus, then Crucify him. Jesus dies on the cross, and is buried in a nearby tomb.

#### **Summaries**

Mark 15 in the Bible is the story of the crucifixion of Jesus Christ. Christ is betrayed by Judas, arrested, and brought before the Sanhedrin. He is then turned over to the Romans and is sentenced to death by crucifixion. Christ is crucified between two thieves, and his body is taken down and buried in a tomb.

The book of Mark tells the story of Jesus Christ, from his humble beginnings as a carpenter's son to his eventual crucifixion. Along the way, Jesus preaches the gospel and performs miracles, ultimately leading to his death on the cross.
