Mark / Chapter 16

Short Summaries

In <u>Mark 16</u>, the angel of the Lord tells the women at the tomb of Jesus that he is not there, and that he has risen from the dead. The women are then to go and tell the disciples, which they do.

Mark 16 tells the story of the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Christ rises from the dead and appears to his disciples, commissioning them to go forth and spread the Good News.

Summaries

The final chapter of Mark's gospel describes the events surrounding Jesus' death and resurrection. After being betrayed by Judas, Jesus is brought before the Sanhedrin and condemned to death. He is then crucified and buried in a tomb. On the third day, Jesus rises from the dead and appears to his disciples. He commissions them to spread the gospel to all nations before ascending into heaven.

Jesus is arrested, tried, and sentenced to death. He is crucified and dies. His body is taken down from the cross and buried. On the third day, he rises from the dead and appears to his disciples.
