Mark / Chapter 4

Short Summaries

The disciples ask Jesus to explain the parable of the sower, and Jesus teaches about the kingdom of God, saying that it is like a mustard seed that grows into a large tree.

The kingdom of God is like a seed that grows and spread, even though the farmer sleeps. The farmer represents Jesus and the seed is the word of God.

Summaries

Mark 4 tells the story of Jesus teaching the crowd using parables. He explains the parable of the seed growing, the parable of the four soils, and the parable of the yeast. He also talks about the kingdom of God being like a treasure hidden in a field and like a pearl of great value.

Mark 4 tells the parable of the Sower, who scatters seed on the ground. Some of the seed falls on the path and is eaten by birds; some falls on rocky ground and grows quickly but then dies; some falls on thorns and is choked; and some falls on good soil and produces a crop.
