Mark / Chapter 5

Short Summaries

A woman with a bleeding disorder is healed by Jesus, and he casts out a demon from a man.

A man with an unclean spirit encounters Jesus and is healed. The man then tells the people of the Decapolis what Jesus has done for him.

Summaries

A demon-possessed man lived in the tombs and was not allowed into the city. He was healed by Jesus and then went and told people in the city about what Jesus had done for him.

Jesus cast a legion of demons out of a man and into a herd of pigs. The demons begged Jesus not to send them away, but he did. The pigs ran into a lake and drowned.
